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## **Action Alliance for a Free Switzerland and SVP National Councillor Wyssmann call for a moratorium on modRNA**

**Genetic vaccines should no longer be approved or recommended until clinical trials conducted in accordance with standard scientific practices are available. This demand was made by ABF Switzerland at today's media conference in Bern. National Councillor Wyssmann will submit a motion to this effect.**

Together with prominent scientists, doctors and lawyers, the Action Alliance for a Free Switzerland (ABF Schweiz) and National Councillor and health policy expert Rémy Wyssmann (SVP) are calling for a moratorium on so-called modRNA vaccines. National Councillor Wyssmann will submit a motion to this effect during the spring session of the Federal Assembly. This motion instructs the Federal Council to suspend the authorisation of all vaccine substances for which the Swissmedic regulatory authority cannot provide evidence of phase III clinical trials in accordance with the standards applicable to other medicinal products prior to 2020. These scientific standards include placebo-controlled, double-blind studies with a duration of at least two years and a certain number of participants. 'It is absolutely unacceptable to unleash experimental gene therapy on the population on the basis of such dubious approval decisions and inadequate testing,' says Wyssmann. 'Only a modRNA

moratorium can avert this danger to public health and guarantee compliance with scientific standards.'

### **Clarify key safety and risk issues**

ModRNA vaccinations were promoted as an unavoidable game changer in the context of pandemic management and are still recommended and used today. This is negligent and dangerous due to the lack of scientific standards in the approval process. Nevertheless, the federal government and the cantons continue to push for modRNA vaccinations: they are being included in the National Vaccination Plan (partial revision of the Epidemics Act), and various cantons are introducing or have already introduced compulsory vaccinations.

This urgently needs to be halted. Efficacy, safety and social consequences must first be seriously evaluated. Until then, there should be no legal or strategic codification of modRNA vaccines as a central instrument of vaccination promotion and the national vaccination plan, as provided for in Articles 20 and 21 of the draft partial revision of the Epidemics Act. ModRNA vaccinations are based on a technologically modified RNA platform with intracellular protein expression and often contain DNA contaminants. Such technology must not be politically standardised until key safety and risk issues have been conclusively clarified.



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### **Approval decisions must be reviewed**

Furthermore, ABF Schweiz calls for an independent review of all approval decisions for modRNA vaccinations. Reason: The approvals were granted in an accelerated procedure in accordance with Art. 9a of the Therapeutic Products Act – and without reliable long-term data. In addition, important decision-making criteria are not fully accessible to the public. Despite the massive impact on physical integrity, there is effectively no effective legal control.

In addition, a consistent regulatory reassessment of modRNA vaccinations is needed, taking into account the ATMP (Advanced Therapy Medicinal Products) category in accordance with the Therapeutic Products Act. This requirement arises from the genetic engineering principle of intracellular expression of a coded protein. Products with a comparable biological mode of action are classified as ATMPs for regulatory purposes and are subject to stricter safety, testing and monitoring requirements. However, these do not apply to experimental modRNA vaccines. Such different regulatory treatment of comparable mechanisms of action raises systematic and safety-related questions.

We therefore demand that similar technologies be treated similarly. Renaming gene therapy as ‘vaccination’ is not sufficient to justify different testing procedures. The precautionary principle under the rule of law requires equal treatment based on the mechanism of action – not on political expediency.

### **Stop recommending modRNA for pregnant women!**

Given these facts, it is irresponsible for the federal government to continue to recommend modRNA vaccinations, especially for pregnant women. This is

also underlined by the results of extensive research by Prof. Dr. Konstantin Beck from the University of Lucerne. At the press conference, Beck explained that in Switzerland, the year after modRNA vaccination of pregnant women, there was an exceptionally sharp and sustained decline in births, leading to a historic low in reproduction (1.29 children per woman) and, in three years, to a shortfall of 17,000 births across Switzerland.

In addition, data from 1.3 million Czech women show that since 2022, vaccinated Czech women have consistently had 30 per cent fewer children than unvaccinated women. Beck: ‘It is incomprehensible that a modRNA vaccination recommendation for pregnant women should be maintained in view of the obvious damage caused during pregnancy, especially since this modRNA application has never been approved by Swissmedic, is only used off-label in Switzerland and has not been recommended by the US government for almost a year.’

### **Conclusion**

For the reasons stated above, there is an urgent need for a moratorium on genetic vaccines. Such a moratorium on modRNA vaccinations means:

- no further routine use;
- no extension of indications;
- no incorporation into law.

Instead, the precautionary principle must be applied. The rule of law must be strengthened and physical integrity protected. A transparent reassessment of modRNA vaccines is needed. As long as crucial regulatory, scientific and liability issues have not been conclusively clarified, caution is the first duty.

### **Dr. Daniel F. Beutler:**

- ‘ModRNA technology differs fundamentally from conventional vaccination principles and has been virtually unresearched in this area of application. According to the Robert Koch Institute in Germany, it was assumed that relevant data on efficacy and safety would only be collected “post-marketing”. The vaccination campaign was therefore a global field trial. All the associated constraints were unlawful.’
- ‘The modRNA vaccination leads to the uncontrolled and uncontrollable production of a

foreign protein (spike protein) in the body. To date, manufacturers have been unable to answer the question of where, for how long and how much of this foreign protein is produced. On the other hand, high concentrations of spike proteins were found in the blood of vaccine-damaged individuals, in some cases years after the last vaccination.’

### **Philipp Kruse, Attorney-at-Law, LL.M.**

- ‘To date, serious deficiencies in the approval procedure for modRNA vaccines are being ignored. Effective legal control is impossible.’
- ‘A moratorium on the approval of modRNA vaccines is legally, politically and ethically imperative.’

### **Andrea Staubli, Attorney-at-Law:**

- ‘The revision of the Epidemics Act clearly shows where we are headed. Vaccinations are being expanded on a broad scale. This also includes the highly controversial modRNA vaccinations.’
- ‘While the national vaccination plan makes vaccination recommendations (including modRNA) and health professionals implement them, the cantons are to offer vaccinations (including modRNA) in pharmacies, schools and workplaces and ensure that vaccinations can be administered quickly and easily.’
- ‘In addition, the cantons are expanding compulsory vaccination requirements and in some cases even imposing fines of tens of thousands of Swiss francs for violations. If compulsory vaccination requirements are imposed for such modRNA injections, the whole situation looks very bleak.’
